Approval of the Minutes of the 2021 AGM

Chairman's Report on the previous year

Treasurer's Report

Accounts for 2021 had been circulated prior to the meeting along with a forecast and commentary. It was highlighted that as it had been agreed that there wouldn't be an awards presentation during 2022 this cost had been removed from the forecast.

There being no queries from the meeting the accounts were adopted unanimously Proposed Maidstone &MKMC (Liz Jordan) , seconded Chelmsford MC (Tony Clements).

The treasurer was thanked for the comprehensive accounts.

Election of Officials for 2022/23
